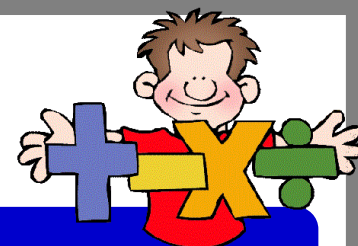


Home Learning

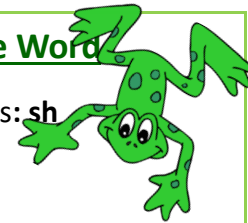
