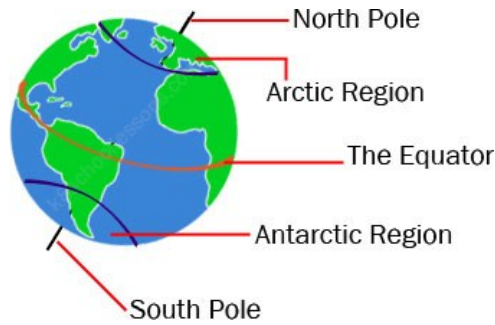
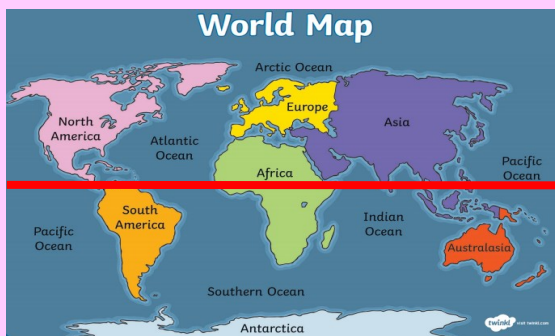

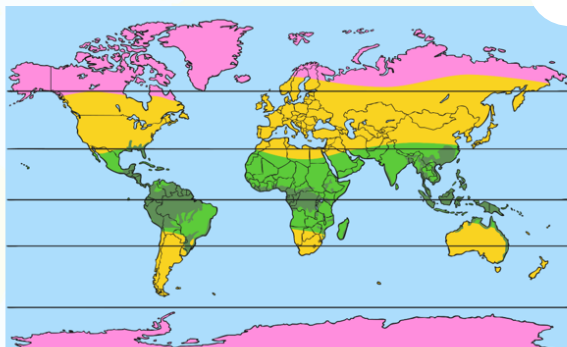

Subject Specific Vocabulary

Hot	Something that has a lot of heat. For example, the sun.
Cold	Something that has a low temperature. For example, ice.
Equator	The equator is an imaginary circle around Earth. It divides Earth into two equal parts: the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere.
North pole	The North Pole is the northernmost place on Earth. There is no land at the North Pole, but it is covered in a thick layer of ice.
South pole	The South Pole is the most southern point on the Earth. It is in Antarctica.
Weather	What the sky is doing everyday e.g. sunshine, rain, cloudy.
Continent	A continent is a large, solid area of land. Earth has seven continents.
Country	A country is land that is controlled by a single government.
Island	An island is any land area surrounded entirely by water.
