different questions:

1. $52 + 20 =$

2. $95 - 40 =$

3. $23 + 34 =$

4. $84 - 33 =$

5. $6 + 4 + 3 =$

6. $56 + \underline{\quad} = 86$

7. $\frac{1}{4}$ of $12 =$

8. $\frac{1}{2}$ of $20 =$

9. $59 + 32 =$

10. $64 - 56 =$

11. $50 + \underline{\quad} = 100$

12. $\frac{1}{4}$ of $\underline{\quad} = 3$

13. $4 \times 3 =$

14. $5 \times 2 =$

15. $6 \times 10 =$

16. $5 \times \underline{\quad} = 30$

17. $25 \div 5 =$
