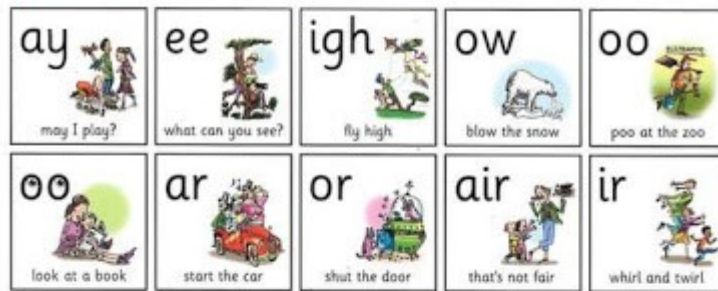


English: Reading

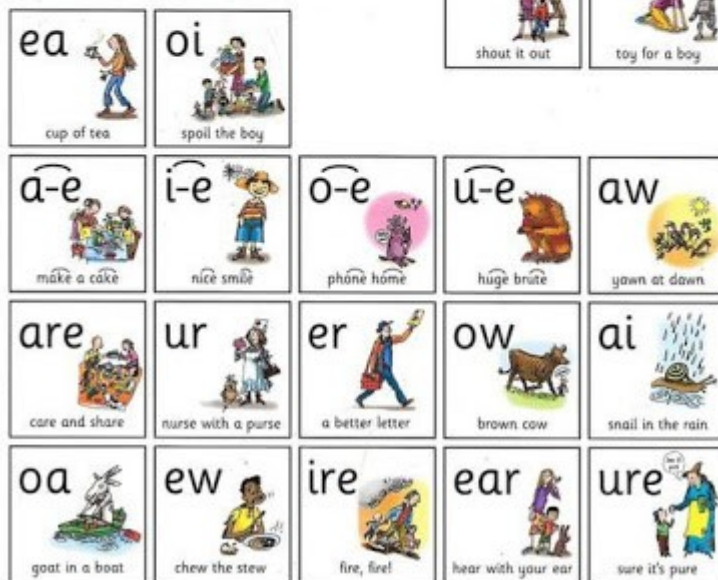
In Year 2, we are learning to build our fluency. Children should be reading at least 90 words per minute.

Most children have completed and passed the phonic screening test and therefore should know all of their sounds. Here is a sound chart for you to refer to when reading with your children.

These sounds must also be used to support your child with spelling also.



Year 2 Expectations

Please ensure your child reads every day. This doesn't have to be a book, it could be a leaflet, TV show, letter or anything else that involves them reading!

Comprehension!

In Year 2, we are always focusing on reading for understanding. We have been looking at lots of different question types and skills over the last term including the following:

Question Types:

- Multiple Choice
- Identify one thing
- Find and copy - vocabulary
- Matching
- Ordering events
- True or false

Reading skills:

- Vocabulary
- Inference
- Predict
- Explain
- Retrieve
- Summarise



Children are familiar with these question types, so you can ask them to do different activities with the reading they have been completing at home.
