Superhero hold a sentence!

Make sure you have got your mind map from last week with your superhero key words on!

Today we are going to be writing a sentence, including some of the words that we wrote last week!

Fast, scary, strong, good

Here are some example superhero sentences:

batman can run fast

the joker is scary

hulk has strong arms

wonderwoman is good

Challenge: capital letters and full stops.

Bigger challenge: adding the word and to a sentence: batman is fast and strong.

Remember if they can read it and so can you, then they're using their phonics perfectly. If your child wrote gud, you could correct this through modelling 'oo makes a 'u' sound g-oo-d = good.'

Spellings

In Reception, each phonics lesson has a **Fred Finger Spellings** session.

1. An adult will show 3 fingers, and then say a word with 3 sounds 'mat',
2. **Say it** Next, your child will repeat the word 'mat'
3. **Make it** Your child will then display 3 fingers and segment the word - **m a t**
4. **Write it** Finally, using those segmented sounds, your child will write them down to create the word.
5. **Use it** Write a sentence using the word – *The cat sat on the mat.*

Sounds Books Spellings:

sad, pig, at, on, mop, cot

Red Books Spellings:

chin, quiz, sink, bath, pool
(red bookmark words too)

Green Book Spellings:

bright, clown, sleep, fair, park, boat, blow
(green bookmark words too)
