Superhero draw and describe!

Make sure you have got your mind map from the first week with your superhero keywords on! Also, you may want to look at your Superhero Sentences to help you!

Today we are going to be drawing and describing our superhero (or toys at home!) I want you to be including some of the words that we've been using!

Fast, scary, strong, good
Here are some example superhero sentences: (red words too!)

I have blue pants
I can run fast
My laugh is scary
You cannot catch me I am too fast!
He is strong

There are **two separate templates** which you could use, one is a **simple** version, which you can label and draw your superhero, the other is a **challenge**, where you will write a description of your superhero using sentences! so make sure you have a go at the right one for you!

Challenge: capital letters and full stops.
Bigger challenge: adding the word **and** to a sentence: batman is fast **and** strong.

Spellings

In Reception, each phonics lesson has a **Fred Finger Spellings** session.

1. An adult will show 3 fingers, and then say a word with 3 sounds 'mat',
2. **Say it** Next, your child will repeat the word 'mat'
3. **Make it** Your child will then display 3 fingers and segment the word - **m a t**
4. **Write it** Finally, using those segmented sounds, your child will write them down to create the word.
5. **Use it** Write a sentence using the word – *The cat sat on the mat.*

Sounds Books Spellings:

sun, bat, on, sit, hat, bed

Red Books Spellings:

cap, kick, bath, book, bark
(red bookmark words too)

Green Book Spellings:

make, stink, party, coat, float, play
(green bookmark words too)
