Silly Soup!

You will need: two different coloured pieces of paper, pens, scissors, a large bowl, a large spoon and a small bowl.

Let's make some silly soup, this is one of my favourite games to play as we can have fun and learn at the same time!

On one coloured piece of paper, write consonant sounds such as: **b, c, d, f, g, h, j, k, i, m, n, p, q, r, s, t, v, w, x, y z**
on the other coloured piece of paper, write **2 SETS** of vowel sounds which are:

a, e, i, o, u

Fold them all up and chuck them into the big bowl.

- 1.) Mix up the letters in the bowl, saying "silly soup, silly soup, we're going to make some silly soup!"
- 2.) Pick out three letters, you will need two consonants (First coloured paper) and one vowel (your other coloured piece of paper) to make our CVC words such as; **mat m-a-t** , **cup, c-u,p, zog z-o-g.**
- 3.) We usually flick the sounds in to the air to make it a bit more exciting or pretend we are detectives and we have to pick out the sounds and

Play **picnic on Pluto with Obb and Bob**, go on phase 2 to begin with and if you feel like challenging yourself or phase two is too easy, try phase 3!

Obb and Bob are brothers who love to eat, but they like to eat different things! Bob likes to eat snacks with real words on them and Obb likes to eat snacks with our alien words on! Can you drag the right snack to each brother?

Also have a go at the **tricky words truck** game:

Trucks will drive up bringing words on them, you need to read the words aloud, how quickly can you go?

blend the words to crack the code, whatever works for you! Unfold your letter and form your word, encourage your child to say the sounds out loud and then blend them together to create their word, it's more likely that you are going to make a "silly" word that isn't real such as **Zok, kam, dov** etc!

4.) As you pronounce your word, is it a real word? or is it one of our alien words? this is where we can be a little silly, if it's an alien word, which is a word that isn't real, we get to put those sounds in the small bowl, give it a little stir and tip the silly soup over your head!

5.) Make some more silly soup!!
