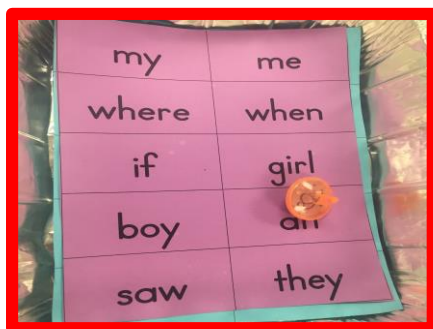

Red Words Challenge

See below for word examples

This week our Phonics focus is **Red Words** – also known as ‘sight words’, ‘tricky words’ or words that Fred cannot sound out!

To challenge your phonics activity further, I would like your writing activity to be a land on the **Red Word**, read it and then write it!



In the pictured activity, I have used a turkey foil tray and a spinner from a Christmas cracker! I spin the spinner, read the word it lands on and write it! You can use numerous resources from around the home to do this: chalk and water pistols outdoors, a football and word cards, counters or marbles with word cards – anything that you have to move that can land on a word!

Whoever has the most written words at the end is the winner!

Spellings

In Reception, each phonics lesson has a **Fred Finger Spellings** session.

1. An adult will show 3 fingers, and then say a word with 3 sounds ‘**mat**’,
2. **Say it** Next, your child will repeat the word ‘**mat**’
3. **Make it** Your child will then display 3 fingers and segment the word - **m a t**
4. **Write it** Finally, using those segmented sounds, your child will write them down to create the word.
5. **Use it** Write a sentence using the word – *The cat sat on the mat.*

Sounds Books Spellings:
sat, pig, hen, bug, cat

Red Books Spellings:
chip, doll, map, sock, mess
(red bookmark words too)

Green Book Spellings:
went, ask, next, chest, hand, sink
green bookmark words too)
