The Very Hungry Caterpillar - What Will My Caterpillar Need?

Our new story is The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle! You may want to re-read/ watch the story again to refresh your memory! By now we should be Caterpillar experts!

This week you are going to complete the worksheet on our area of the website labelled What will my caterpillar need?

Similar to last week, there will be **two different documents** for you to complete, one is a **simple version** and the other is a **challenge**, complete whichever one you feel is best suited to you!

On the simple worksheet, you will need to draw a picture of a caterpillar and label it! Talk to your grown up about where caterpillars may live, what food do they like to eat? Label these around your caterpillar using your phonics knowledge to help you write or draw pictures and your adult scribe if this is a bit tricky!

On the Challenger worksheet, you will be writing sentences! Draw a picture of your caterpillar and complete the sentences. Have a go at reading the sentences yourself, but be sure to ask your grown up for help if you are stuck! Don't forget to talk to your grown up about all the things you now know about caterpillars!

Spellings

In Reception, each phonics lesson has a **Fred Finger Spellings** session.

1. An adult will show 3 fingers, and then say a word with 3 sounds 'mat',
2. **Say it** Next, your child will repeat the word 'mat'
3. **Make it** Your child will then display 3 fingers and segment the word - **m a t**
4. **Write it** Finally, using those segmented sounds, your child will write them down to create the word.
5. **Use it** Write a sentence using the word – *The cat sat on the mat.*

Red Books Spellings:

**fold, bell, muck, frog, dust, flask
(red bookmark words too)**

Green Book Spellings:

**flake, hive, cope, cube, kite, chase
green bookmark words too)**
